**Text:** John 4:1-18

**Passage Summary:** As we survey the life and ministry of Jesus, we discover that when He shared the \_\_\_\_\_ of His Heavenly Father in John 3:16, He \_\_\_\_\_ it!

**180 Degree Truth #1:** See that as Jesus ministers to a lost and dying world, He likens the gift of \_\_\_\_\_ life He has come to offer as \_\_\_\_\_ water! (4:1-18)

**Application:** Recognize that when it comes to the living water that symbolizes eternal life, it is essential to understand...
